VENUE

Forever Matinkylä, Matinkartanontie 1, 02230 Espoo, Finland / Google-map Tournament will be played on 13 courts

EVENTS

Boys' (BS) and girls' (GS) singles, boys' (BD) and girls' (GD) doubles and mixed doubles (XD) in each age category.

U19: players born in 2006 or later U17: players born in 2008 or later U15: players born in 2010 or later U13: players born in 2012 or later U11: players born in 2014 or later

A player can participate in maximum in three events: one singles, one doubles and one mixed double.

The organizer has the right to cancel an event with too few entries, or to combine such an event with the same type of event of an older age group.

DRAW

In the singles events, preliminary pools of 3 or 4 players will be played. The two best players of each pool will continue to the main draw and the other players will continue to the consolation draw except in U15, U17 and U19 where only main draw will be played. The main and consolation draws will be played in a knock-out system.





The doubles events will be played in a knock-out system.

In U11 and U13 events, a bronze-medal match will be played only in the main draw.

The seeding and draw will be done by the organizers and the referee, according to Finnish Junior Elite tour regulations.

ENTRY FEES AND PAYMENT

Entry fees for the tournament are (shuttlecocks included):

EUR 37 per player in singles events.

EUR 22 per player in doubles events.

The Member Association is responsible for paying the entry fees. The entry fee becomes due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes.

The entry fees are invoiced and must be paid by bank transfer before the tournament. If the entry fee is not paid in time, the player may not be allowed to start the match.

Organizers are allowed to refuse entries if players have outstanding fees from a previous year(s).
